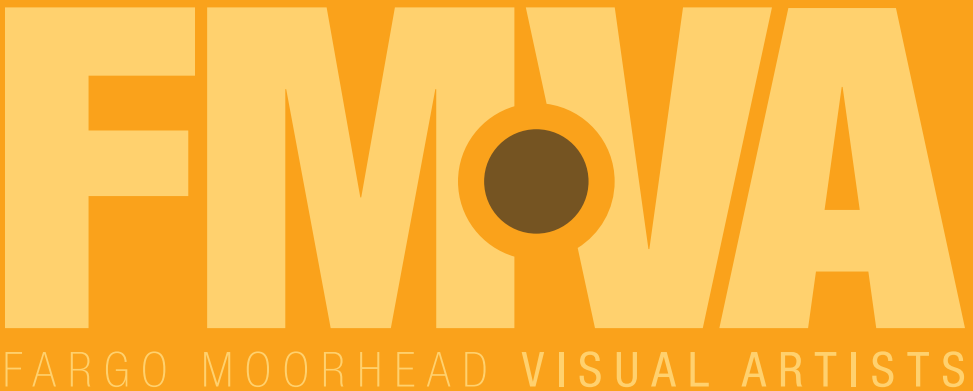
Paging through this brochure, you'll find a talented mix of emerging and established visual artists to visit this weekend, along with special events hosted by our supportive sponsors.

In her downtown Fargo studio, Meg explores alternative methods employing a variety of art mediums—from photography and mixed media to clay. She combines elements that often result in a constructed style. Her recent work captures portrait style images of wild horses and bison as fine art pigment photographs and assembled images on paper and canvas.
